1. Parties

This Bay Oracle Path to Success / Explorer Program Agreement is entered into by and between **Bay Oracle**, operated by **Charlie Safari** and/or **Bay Oracle LLC**, if formed, including its founder, operator, representatives, contractors, successors, assigns, agents, and affiliated service providers, collectively referred to as **“Bay Oracle,” “Company,” “Operator,” “we,” “us,” or “our,”** and the undersigned participating person, referred to as **“Explorer,” “you,” or “your.”**

Bay Oracle and Explorer may be referred to individually as a **“Party”** and collectively as the **“Parties.”**

2. Nature of the Program

The Path to Success / Explorer Program is a structured, non-clinical, spiritual, symbolic, reflective, and experiential program.

The program is designed to guide the Explorer through a sequence of self-observation, personal reflection, symbolic exploration, small experiments, progress review, and integration.

The program may include:

- guided reflection;
- self-observation prompts;
- symbolic mapping;
- attention and environment awareness;
- language awareness;
- small non-clinical practices;
- behavior-loop reflection;
- personal progress review;
- integration summaries;
- readiness review;
- completion materials.

The program is not therapy, psychological treatment, medical care, diagnosis, crisis support, addiction treatment, trauma treatment, professional coaching requiring a license, or any licensed professional service.

The phrase “**Path to Success**” is a Bay Oracle program name only. It does not guarantee success, improvement, transformation, healing, readiness, Journey Work eligibility, emotional relief, life outcomes, financial outcomes, relationship outcomes, career outcomes, health outcomes, or any specific result.

3. Non-Clinical Service Acknowledgment

Explorer understands and agrees that Bay Oracle is not providing:

- therapy;
- psychotherapy;
- psychological counseling;
- mental health treatment;
- psychiatric care;
- medical care;
- medical advice;
- diagnosis;
- treatment;
- detoxification;
- addiction treatment;
- trauma treatment;
- crisis intervention;
- legal advice;
- financial advice;
- employment advice;
- HR services;
- workplace investigation;
- licensed coaching, unless separately defined and legally permitted;

- any service requiring a professional license.

Explorer understands that the program is not a substitute for licensed professional help. If Explorer needs medical, psychological, psychiatric, legal, financial, employment, emergency, or crisis support, Explorer should contact an appropriate licensed professional, emergency service, crisis resource, attorney, financial professional, or other qualified provider.

4. Voluntary Participation

Explorer represents and agrees that participation in the program is voluntary and self-directed.

Explorer confirms that:

- Explorer wants to participate;
- Explorer is not being forced, coerced, threatened, or pressured to participate;
- Explorer is not participating because of emergency need;
- Explorer is not participating as a substitute for necessary licensed care due to lack of money, access, insurance, or other resources;
- Explorer is not participating under a court order, employer mandate, family mandate, third-party requirement, or legally binding arrangement unless Bay Oracle has separately reviewed and approved that arrangement in a written agreement signed by all required parties;
- Explorer may decline any optional tool, exercise, ritual, reflection, reading, group activity, herbal element, plant-based element, sensory element, symbolic element, or optional service component;
- Explorer may ask questions before participating;
- Explorer may stop participation, subject to applicable payment, refund, cancellation, and program terms.

5. Explorer Responsibility

Explorer remains fully responsible for all personal decisions, interpretations, actions, omissions, life choices, relationships, employment choices, medical choices, psychological care decisions, legal decisions, financial decisions, and outcomes.

Bay Oracle may offer symbolic, intuitive, spiritual, reflective, or experiential perspectives, but Bay Oracle does not decide for Explorer and does not assume responsibility for Explorer's choices or outcomes.

Explorer agrees not to treat any Bay Oracle statement, reading, symbol, map, stop name, exercise, ritual, intuitive impression, spiritual framing, session experience, written material,

program report, summary, certificate, readiness note, or recommendation as a command, guarantee, professional advice, diagnosis, treatment plan, legal instruction, financial instruction, medical recommendation, psychological recommendation, or required life decision.

6. Standard Program Structure

The standard Path to Success / Explorer Program may include sixteen sessions divided into four general stages.

Stage One — Evaluation / Awareness

Sessions 1–4 may focus on orientation, reflection, self-observation, attention patterns, environment, language, emotional accessibility, and identifying recurring themes.

Stage Two — Development

Sessions 5–8 may focus on small experiments, behavior-loop awareness, repeatable practices, discipline testing, and practical self-observation.

Stage Three — Efficiency Check / Pattern Review

Sessions 9–12 may focus on reviewing results from prior sessions, identifying what worked, what did not work, what should be simplified, and what may require adjustment or outside support.

Stage Four — Conclusion / Integration

Sessions 13–16 may focus on integration, emotional honesty, release, readiness review, next-step recommendations, and program closure.

Bay Oracle may rename, restructure, modify, combine, shorten, extend, repeat, pause, or discontinue stages based on readiness, participation, safety, scope, scheduling, payment, or Operator discretion.

7. Explorer Map and Themed Materials

Bay Oracle may present the program through an Explorer Map, safari-themed stop names, symbolic locations, worksheets, summaries, logs, reflection prompts, progress notes, or other original program materials.

These materials are symbolic and experiential. They do not create clinical assessments, psychological scores, professional evaluations, guaranteed outcomes, or required life decisions.

Explorer Map names, stop descriptions, worksheets, prompts, summaries, reports, reflection tools, ceremonies, symbolic frameworks, and related materials are Bay Oracle proprietary materials unless otherwise stated.

Explorer may use program materials for personal reflection only and may not copy, reproduce, publish, sell, teach, distribute, record, commercialize, or misrepresent program materials without prior written permission.

8. Participation Requirements

Program participation may require:

- attending scheduled sessions;
- arriving prepared and able to participate;
- completing reflection exercises;
- completing observation logs;
- engaging with agreed non-clinical practices;
- reviewing progress with the Operator;
- communicating scheduling issues in good faith;
- respecting program boundaries;
- avoiding dependency-based use of the program;
- avoiding crisis use of the program;
- understanding that the program is non-clinical;
- accepting that no outcome is guaranteed.

Bay Oracle may determine that an Explorer has not fulfilled program requirements even if all sessions have been attended.

Attendance alone does not guarantee program completion, certificate eligibility, readiness status, future-service eligibility, or any next-stage opportunity.

9. Program Adaptation, Pause, or Repetition

Bay Oracle may adapt the program based on Explorer participation, readiness, safety, scope, schedule, or practical needs.

Bay Oracle may recommend or require that Explorer:

- repeat a session;
- repeat a stage;
- simplify assignments;
- pause the program;
- return to ordinary sessions;
- delay completion;
- discontinue the program;
- seek outside professional support where appropriate.

A recommendation to pause, repeat, simplify, discontinue, or seek outside support is not a diagnosis and does not mean Explorer failed as a person. It means Bay Oracle has determined that continuing the program as planned may not be appropriate at that time.

10. Reports, Summaries, and Readiness Notes

The program may include written or verbal summaries, including but not limited to:

- Personal Reflection Summary;
- Behavior Experiment Summary;
- Pattern Review Summary;
- Integration Summary;
- Completion Summary;
- Readiness and Direction Summary.

These summaries are non-clinical, non-diagnostic, symbolic, reflective, and operational in nature.

They are not medical records, therapy notes, psychological evaluations, psychiatric assessments, treatment plans, clinical progress notes, legal reports, employment evaluations, or professional recommendations.

Bay Oracle does not diagnose Explorer, score Explorer's mental health, determine Explorer's psychological condition, or certify Explorer's fitness for any medical, legal, employment, psychological, or professional purpose.

11. Progress Review and Internal Scoring

Bay Oracle may use internal progress notes, readiness categories, symbolic scoring, completion standards, or participation markers to help determine whether Explorer has fulfilled program requirements.

Any score, category, readiness note, or completion marker is internal, symbolic, non-clinical, and program-specific only.

Such markers are not grades, academic records, employment records, medical conclusions, psychological assessments, legal findings, professional certifications, or objective measurements of Explorer's value, health, ability, character, or future potential.

Bay Oracle may change, modify, disregard, or replace internal scoring or readiness methods at its discretion.

12. Completion and Certificate

Completing all sixteen sessions does not automatically qualify Explorer for program completion, certificate, Journey Work eligibility, or any next-stage service.

Bay Oracle may award a completion certificate only when Bay Oracle determines, in its discretion, that Explorer has met applicable participation, reflection, readiness, and program requirements.

A completion certificate is symbolic, ceremonial, and internal to Bay Oracle. It is not an academic credential, professional credential, therapeutic certification, clinical assessment, medical clearance, psychological clearance, legal document, employment qualification, or guarantee of future service eligibility.

Bay Oracle may decline to issue a completion certificate if participation requirements, readiness standards, safety expectations, scope boundaries, or payment obligations have not been met.

13. Journey Work Eligibility

The program may build readiness for possible Journey Work, but Journey Work is not guaranteed.

Bay Oracle may approve, delay, modify, or decline Journey Work for any reason related to readiness, safety, consent, scope, legality, dependency, crisis risk, program participation, scheduling, payment, or Operator discretion.

Journey Work requires a separate written agreement before any Journey Work begins.

Explorer understands that completion of this program does not automatically create a right to Journey Work, plant-based elements, ceremonial materials, future services, or any next-stage offering.

14. Tools and Optional Elements

Bay Oracle may use spiritual, symbolic, intuitive, reflective, or experiential tools during the program.

These tools may include tarot, oracle cards, psychic framing, intuitive impressions, divination-style reflection, symbolic interpretation, aura-style language, energy-style language, cleanses, grounding exercises, sound tools, silence, guided reflection, journaling, symbolic map work, or related practices.

Explorer understands that these tools are used for reflection, symbolism, and personal exploration only.

Such tools are not objective proof, professional assessment, diagnosis, factual determination, guaranteed prediction, medical information, psychological information, legal information, financial information, or required instruction.

Bay Oracle will not confirm curses, spiritual attacks, hidden dangers, fate, guaranteed future events, or spiritual emergencies as fact.

Bay Oracle may also offer optional refreshments, sensory props, symbolic tools, or lawful plant-based or herbal elements when separately disclosed and permitted by Bay Oracle policy. These elements are optional, non-medical, and not intended to diagnose, treat, cure, prevent, mitigate, manage, or improve any disease, condition, symptom, mental health concern, emotional state, burnout, anxiety, trauma, stress, addiction, dopamine issue, nervous system issue, or physical issue. Explorer remains responsible for allergies, sensitivities, dietary restrictions, medication interactions, pregnancy-related concerns, medical conditions, and personal suitability. Explorer should not request illegal, controlled, psychedelic, or mind-altering substances, and should refrain from bringing their own. Bay Oracle may refuse or terminate service at any time; applicable refund guidelines apply.

15. No Guaranteed Program Outcomes

Bay Oracle does not guarantee any result, outcome, benefit, prediction, transformation, relief, spiritual experience, emotional change, relationship result, employment result, financial result, health result, legal result, program completion, certificate eligibility, Journey Work eligibility, future-service eligibility, or life result.

Explorer understands that all experiences are subjective and may vary.

Bay Oracle does not guarantee:

- successful completion;
- certificate issuance;
- Journey Work approval;
- psychic accuracy;
- future prediction;
- emotional relief;
- healing;
- reduced stress;
- reduced anxiety;
- burnout recovery;
- trauma release;
- dopamine repair;
- spiritual protection;
- relationship reconciliation;
- career success;
- financial gain;
- medical improvement;
- psychological improvement;
- crisis resolution;
- personal transformation;
- Explorer satisfaction.

The program is a structured opportunity for reflection, self-observation, symbolic exploration, personal insight, and non-clinical experiential development only.

16. Crisis and Emergency Limitations

Bay Oracle is not a crisis service.

Bay Oracle does not provide suicide intervention, emergency care, abuse intervention, domestic violence intervention, medical emergency response, psychiatric crisis support, or harm-prevention services.

If Explorer is in immediate danger, may harm themselves, may harm another person, is experiencing a medical emergency, is experiencing abuse or danger, or cannot remain safe, Explorer should contact emergency services, 988 in the United States for suicide or crisis support, a qualified crisis resource, medical provider, trusted person nearby, or other appropriate immediate support.

If Bay Oracle becomes aware of immediate safety concerns, Bay Oracle may stop the session or program and direct Explorer to crisis, emergency, medical, legal, or other appropriate support. Bay Oracle may also disclose limited information if disclosure is required or permitted by law, necessary to address immediate safety concerns, necessary to respond to legal process, or necessary to defend Bay Oracle against claims.

Explorer understands that Bay Oracle cannot promise absolute confidentiality where safety, legal process, abuse reporting requirements, emergency circumstances, or legal defense needs are involved.

17. Confidentiality and Privacy

Bay Oracle will make reasonable efforts to keep Explorer communications private and confidential.

Bay Oracle will not intentionally disclose private Explorer program information except as described in this Agreement or as otherwise permitted by Explorer.

Bay Oracle does not sell Explorer information. Bay Oracle does not intentionally collect or capture unnecessary personal data, and will keep only limited information needed for scheduling, payment, consent, basic administration, program operation, or legally appropriate recordkeeping.

Bay Oracle may disclose Explorer information only when legally required, reasonably necessary to operate the program, authorized by Explorer, or necessary in limited circumstances such as:

- scheduling;
- payment processing;
- basic business administration;
- legal consultation;
- tax or accounting purposes;
- insurance purposes;
- responding to legal process;
- defending against claims or threatened claims;
- addressing immediate safety concerns;
- complying with law;
- reporting where required or permitted by law;
- preventing or responding to threats, harassment, extortion, abuse, fraud, or unlawful conduct;
- protecting Bay Oracle, Explorer, or others from serious harm.

Bay Oracle does not provide attorney-client privilege, physician-patient privilege, therapist-patient privilege, psychotherapist-patient privilege, clergy privilege, or any licensed professional confidentiality privilege unless separately established by applicable law.

18. Explorer Confidentiality, Non-Disclosure, No Recording, and No Reproduction

Explorer agrees to respect the confidentiality, privacy, proprietary methods, original materials, and program integrity of Bay Oracle.

Explorer agrees not to:

- audio record sessions without prior written permission;
- video record sessions without prior written permission;
- photograph private program materials without permission;
- livestream sessions;
- secretly record calls, video sessions, or in-person sessions;
- publish private program content;
- copy Bay Oracle scripts, methods, exercises, rituals, layouts, written materials, readings, prompts, forms, worksheets, summaries, reports, maps, stop names, or proprietary presentation;
- reproduce Bay Oracle materials for commercial use;
- teach, sell, distribute, or represent Bay Oracle methods as Explorer's own;
- misrepresent Bay Oracle statements, services, claims, or outcomes;
- disclose private information shared by other participants in a group session.

General personal impressions and non-confidential aesthetic inspiration are not prohibited, provided Explorer does not copy Bay Oracle materials, disclose private program content, record without permission, misrepresent Bay Oracle, or use Bay Oracle's work commercially without permission.

Explorer understands that confidential communications may require consent of all parties before recording. Explorer agrees not to record any Bay Oracle session unless all required parties have clearly consented in advance.

19. Explorer Conduct

Explorer agrees to behave respectfully and safely.

Explorer must not:

- threaten the Operator or others;
- harass the Operator or others;
- act violently or abusively;
- bring illegal substances into sessions;
- bring weapons into sessions unless legally required for the setting and disclosed in advance;
- attend while intoxicated or unable to consent;
- pressure others to participate;
- record without permission;
- demand services outside scope;

- request illegal activity;
- request crisis handling beyond referral;
- request guaranteed predictions;
- request medical, psychological, legal, financial, or employment advice;
- request curse removal or fear-based spiritual intervention;
- misuse Bay Oracle for stalking, coercion, revenge, manipulation, or harassment of third parties.

Bay Oracle may refuse, pause, modify, or terminate the program if Explorer conduct creates safety, legal, ethical, operational, privacy, or boundary concerns.

20. Pricing, Payment, Program Fees, and Custom Terms

Explorer agrees to pay the price disclosed before the program begins or before any paid program stage begins.

Bay Oracle will disclose applicable pricing, session duration, program fees, payment schedule, refund terms, cancellation terms, missed-session terms, rescheduling terms, custom charges, material charges if any, and travel charges if any before service begins.

Program pricing may be structured as a package, by session, by stage, by installment, or by another written pricing structure approved by Bay Oracle.

Program fees pay for time, structure, availability, preparation, facilitation, review, and non-clinical experiential services. Fees are not payment for guaranteed transformation, healing, emotional relief, diagnosis, treatment, professional evaluation, certificate entitlement, Journey Work approval, or Explorer satisfaction.

If a session is extended beyond the originally agreed time, any additional charge must be disclosed and accepted before paid extension occurs.

21. Refunds, Cancellation, Missed Sessions, and Rescheduling

Bay Oracle does not guarantee Explorer satisfaction, specific results, emotional relief, spiritual experience, accuracy, transformation, certificate eligibility, Journey Work eligibility, or any particular outcome.

Refunds are based on the written program refund rules, not on whether Explorer liked, agreed with, or felt satisfied by the program.

Unless otherwise stated in writing:

- completed sessions are not refundable after they have been provided;
- missed sessions may be forfeited, rescheduled, or credited only according to written policy;
- program fees do not guarantee completion, certificate eligibility, Journey Work eligibility, or access to later stages;
- Bay Oracle may pause, delay, modify, or discontinue program participation if safety, readiness, scope, dependency, crisis, consent, payment, scheduling, or boundary concerns arise;
- Explorer dissatisfaction with subjective experience, lack of desired outcome, lack of certificate eligibility, or lack of Journey Work approval does not automatically create a refund right unless written policy provides otherwise.

If Bay Oracle cancels a paid program session for a Bay Oracle-side reason, Bay Oracle will provide the refund, credit, or rescheduling remedy stated in the written program terms.

Bay Oracle may limit, pause, or refuse future service if cancellation, refund, rescheduling, no-show, chargeback, or payment behavior becomes abusive, fraudulent, coercive, threatening, repeated in bad faith, or disruptive to Bay Oracle operations.

22. Scheduling and Communication Outside Program Sessions

Bay Oracle may offer scheduled, virtual, in-person, hybrid, text-based, or custom program sessions depending on program format and Operator discretion.

Bay Oracle does not guarantee availability, immediate response, same-day service, continued text availability, program continuation, Journey Work approval, or any future appointment.

Bay Oracle does not provide unlimited or ongoing support between sessions.

Permitted outside-session communication may include:

- scheduling;
- payment;
- logistics;
- brief clarification;
- official follow-up where appropriate;
- administrative communication;
- limited unpaid text interaction approved by Bay Oracle.

Bay Oracle does not provide by text, phone, email, social media, or messaging:

- crisis support;
- emergency support;
- ongoing emotional processing;
- repeated divination questions;
- medical advice;
- psychological advice;
- legal advice;
- financial advice;
- life decision-making;
- dependency-style contact;
- urgent reassurance loops.

Bay Oracle may decline to respond to messages outside scope.

23. Refusal, Pause, or Termination of Program

Bay Oracle may refuse, pause, modify, reschedule, or terminate the program if Bay Oracle determines that continuing is unsafe, outside scope, inappropriate, unlawful, unethical, coercive, unclear, ineffective, dependency-producing, crisis-adjacent, or inconsistent with this Agreement or Bay Oracle's internal protocols.

Reasons may include, but are not limited to:

- crisis indicators;
- suicidal language;
- harm-to-others threats;
- medical emergency;
- abuse disclosure requiring outside support;
- Explorer inability to consent;
- intoxication or impairment;
- requests for illegal substances;
- requests for psychedelic or mind-altering facilitation;
- requests for medical, psychological, legal, financial, or employment advice;
- repeated demand for guaranteed prediction;
- repeated fixation;
- dependency behavior;
- threats, harassment, abuse, or unsafe conduct;
- recording without consent;
- refusal to accept non-clinical scope;
- refusal to accept pricing, consent, privacy, recording, or boundary terms;
- incomplete participation requirements;
- readiness concerns.

If service is terminated, refund or rescheduling will be handled according to written policy and applicable law.

24. Assumption of Ordinary Risks

Explorer understands that the program may involve personal reflection, symbolic interpretation, emotionally meaningful conversation, spiritual themes, self-observation, behavior reflection, group participation if applicable, or exposure to ideas that may feel surprising, uncomfortable, challenging, disappointing, confusing, or emotionally activating.

Explorer voluntarily assumes ordinary risks associated with participating in non-clinical spiritual, symbolic, reflective, and experiential services, including but not limited to:

- subjective dissatisfaction;
- emotional discomfort;
- disagreement with interpretations;
- unexpected feelings;
- symbolic confusion;
- lack of desired outcome;
- personal reflection after session;
- disappointment;
- changed perspective;
- post-session distress not caused by unlawful conduct;
- Explorer decisions made after session;
- failure to complete the program;
- ineligibility for certificate;
- ineligibility for Journey Work;
- ordinary risks related to optional refreshments, sensory props, symbolic tools, grounding practices, or lawful plant-based or herbal elements.

Explorer understands that Bay Oracle does not guarantee that the program will feel positive, accurate, healing, comforting, satisfying, useful, successful, or complete.

25. Release and Waiver of Claims

To the maximum extent permitted by California law, Explorer releases, waives, and agrees not to bring claims against Bay Oracle LLC, Bay Oracle, Charlie Safari individually, and any representatives, agents, contractors, successors, assigns, or affiliated persons for claims arising from ordinary risks, subjective dissatisfaction, emotional discomfort, personal interpretation, spiritual disagreement, Explorer decisions, third-party reactions, post-session distress, lack of

desired outcome, program incompleteness, lack of certificate eligibility, lack of Journey Work approval, future-service ineligibility, or outcomes not guaranteed by Bay Oracle.

This release includes ordinary risks related to optional refreshments, sensory props, symbolic tools, grounding practices, and lawful plant-based or herbal elements, including subjective discomfort, dissatisfaction, personal unsuitability, unexpected reaction, or post-session distress not caused by unlawful conduct.

This release does not apply to claims that cannot lawfully be waived, including claims arising from fraud, willful misconduct, gross negligence, criminal conduct, intentional harm, violations of law, or other conduct for which liability cannot be limited under applicable law.

Explorer understands that this waiver is intended to be as broad as legally permitted, while preserving any rights that cannot lawfully be waived.

26. Limitation of Liability

To the maximum extent permitted by law, Bay Oracle's total liability for claims arising from or related to the program shall not exceed the amount actually paid by Explorer to Bay Oracle for the specific program service giving rise to the claim, or one hundred dollars (\$100), whichever is greater.

This limitation does not apply to liability that cannot lawfully be limited, including liability for fraud, willful misconduct, gross negligence, criminal conduct, intentional injury, violations of law, or other non-waivable claims.

Explorer understands and agrees that Bay Oracle does not accept liability for Explorer decisions, Explorer interpretations, third-party actions, employment outcomes, relationship outcomes, financial outcomes, medical outcomes, psychological outcomes, legal outcomes, spiritual outcomes, program incompleteness, certificate ineligibility, Journey Work ineligibility, or events outside Bay Oracle's direct control.

Bay Oracle is not liable for issues arising from Explorer's undisclosed allergies, sensitivities, dietary restrictions, medication interactions, medical conditions, personal suitability, or voluntary use of optional refreshments, sensory props, symbolic tools, or lawful plant-based or herbal elements, except where liability cannot lawfully be limited.

27. Indemnification

To the maximum extent permitted by law, Explorer agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Bay Oracle LLC, Bay Oracle, Charlie Safari individually, and any representatives,

agents, contractors, successors, assigns, or affiliated persons from and against claims, losses, damages, liabilities, costs, expenses, and attorney fees arising out of or related to:

- Explorer's breach of this Agreement;
- Explorer's misuse of Bay Oracle services;
- Explorer's recording, publishing, reproducing, or misrepresenting Bay Oracle content;
- Explorer's false statements;
- Explorer's threats, harassment, blackmail, extortion, or coercive conduct;
- Explorer's unlawful conduct;
- Explorer's violation of another person's rights;
- Explorer's disclosure of other participants' private information;
- Explorer's failure to disclose relevant safety or consent concerns;
- Explorer's decisions or actions after receiving Bay Oracle services;
- Explorer's misuse of program materials, maps, reports, summaries, or symbolic tools.

This clause does not require indemnification where prohibited by law.

28. No Professional Relationship Beyond Agreement

Explorer understands that this Agreement does not create any professional licensed-care relationship, fiduciary relationship, therapist-client relationship, physician-patient relationship, attorney-client relationship, financial advisor-client relationship, employment advisor-client relationship, clergy relationship, emergency-care relationship, or crisis-support relationship.

The relationship is limited to the paid or agreed Bay Oracle spiritual, symbolic, intuitive, reflective, and experiential program described in this Agreement.

29. Intellectual Property and Proprietary Materials

Bay Oracle retains ownership of its original materials, methods, scripts, prompts, rituals, worksheets, service names, branding, written content, session structures, exercises, symbolic frameworks, maps, stop names, summaries, reports, completion materials, and proprietary presentation.

Explorer receives only a limited, personal, non-transferable right to participate in the program.

Explorer may not copy, reproduce, teach, publish, sell, distribute, adapt, record, livestream, commercialize, or misrepresent Bay Oracle materials or methods without prior written permission.

30. Privacy, Records, and Data

Bay Oracle may maintain limited business and program records, including booking details, payment records, consent records, service type, session dates, refund status, program status, certificate status, readiness status, and factual incident logs where necessary.

Bay Oracle does not maintain medical records, therapy records, psychiatric records, clinical notes, or treatment records.

Bay Oracle may use third-party platforms for booking, payment, forms, email, text, or video services. Explorer understands that third-party services have their own privacy and security terms.

Bay Oracle will make reasonable efforts to protect Explorer information but cannot guarantee absolute security of electronic communications or third-party platforms.

31. Recording Policy

Bay Oracle program sessions are not recorded unless all required parties agree in advance.

Explorer may not record audio, video, phone calls, online meetings, in-person sessions, group sessions, ceremonies, or private conversations without prior written permission from Bay Oracle and any other required participants.

Bay Oracle may refuse, terminate, or take legal action if Explorer records without consent.

32. Testimonials, Reviews, and Public Statements

Explorer may leave honest reviews based on Explorer's personal experience, provided Explorer does not make knowingly false statements, disclose private information of others, misrepresent Bay Oracle services, or claim that Bay Oracle provides guaranteed outcomes, therapy, medical care, psychological treatment, crisis care, certification, Journey Work approval, or licensed professional services.

Bay Oracle may request permission before using any Explorer testimonial in marketing.

Testimonials must not be used to imply guaranteed results, medical benefits, psychological benefits, cure, treatment, crisis resolution, program completion, certificate entitlement, Journey Work eligibility, or predictive certainty.

33. Dispute Resolution

The Parties agree to first attempt to resolve any dispute informally and in good faith.

Before filing a lawsuit or arbitration, the complaining Party should provide written notice describing the dispute and allow at least thirty (30) days for informal resolution, unless immediate legal action is necessary to prevent harm, preserve rights, comply with legal deadlines, address unlawful conduct, or seek emergency relief.

Optional future dispute procedures, including arbitration or small claims procedures, may be added only by written agreement.

Until a separate arbitration clause is adopted in writing, this Agreement does not require binding arbitration.

34. Governing Law and Venue

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of California, without regard to conflict-of-law rules.

Subject to any valid dispute-resolution provision, venue for disputes shall be in a court of competent jurisdiction in California, unless another venue is required by law or agreed in writing.

35. Severability

If any part of this Agreement is found unenforceable, invalid, void, or unlawful, the remaining parts shall remain in effect to the fullest extent permitted by law.

Any unenforceable provision shall be modified to the minimum extent necessary to make it enforceable, if permitted by law. If modification is not permitted, the provision shall be severed and the remainder of the Agreement shall continue.

36. Entire Agreement

This Agreement, together with any booking confirmation, written pricing confirmation, written program terms, or written service-specific terms, constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties regarding the Path to Success / Explorer Program.

This Agreement supersedes prior oral or written statements regarding the same program.

No verbal statement modifies this Agreement unless confirmed in writing by Bay Oracle.

37. Amendments

Bay Oracle may update its agreements, policies, pricing, service descriptions, refund terms, program descriptions, eligibility requirements, and protocols from time to time.

The version accepted by Explorer at booking or program start governs that program unless otherwise agreed in writing.

Any material change for a scheduled program should be disclosed before the affected service begins.

38. Acknowledgment of Understanding

By signing below or accepting this Agreement electronically, Explorer acknowledges that Explorer has read, understood, and agrees to this Agreement.

- Explorer satisfaction is not guaranteed;
- attendance alone does not guarantee completion;
- completion certificates are symbolic and discretionary;
- Journey Work eligibility is not automatic;
- confidentiality has limits;
- Explorer may not record without permission;
- Explorer may not copy or reproduce Bay Oracle materials or methods;
- Explorer may not make threats, blackmail attempts, extortionate demands, false statements, or coercive claims;
- Explorer releases and waives claims to the maximum extent permitted by law;
- non-waivable claims remain preserved as required by law;
- Explorer should seek licensed professional or emergency support when needed;
